- ✓ Monitoring and analyzing **student attendance** on a daily basis, providing explicit feedback to students, families and the community, and targeting intervention accordingly.
- Connecting individual and small groups of students with targeted social, emotional and wellbeing supports that enable increased engagement and academic outcomes.
- ✓ Upgrade **learning environments** to facilitate engagement in classroom learning with focus on high-yield strategies across all aspects of the Australian Curriculum.
